SPORTS UNIFORM

All learners are required to participate in Physical Education. Non-participation will require a valid doctor's note. Physical Education affords learners the opportunity to learn and improve a variety of skills. It also forms part of the school curriculum and marks are awarded to each learner for participation and skill.



The Physical Education uniform consists of:

- Red collared shirt with school badge;
- Grey shorts;
- School tracksuit;
- White long-sleeved fleece-lined School top (Winter only);
- White short socks no secret socks;
- Takkies or sports shoes (white only. No Tomy-Takkies).

No other garment may be worn as part of the uniform, i.e. the schools jersey may not be worn over Phys. Ed. Shirt.
