FOOD FOR THOUGHT - Screen Time and Children

An extract from TechnoLife Wise Foundation – Parenting Hub

“ We focus on Active Digital Wellness. This means that we must ACT, and stand together to ensure a bright future for our vulnerable children. We must ensure that they are not over using screens and technology by implementing clear boundaries. Many young children are nowadays diagnosed with ADHD, Autism-like symptoms, and learning and neurological disorders, including squint eyes, epilepsy, etc. The culprit in many of these cases is too much screen time and limited movement. Therefore, the consequences of this is total underdevelopment of the child in a human way through movement and exploration with all their senses in a natural setting. The natural and healthy way of development and learning through play support the unlimited development of a child's unique potential and happiness. ”

Screen time needs to be closely monitored, especially with our Primary School children. Too often our children are allowed to play games for extended periods of time, the screen becomes the “babysitter” or the entertainment. As parents we need to be instrumental in setting firm time limits and boundaries where gaming is concerned.

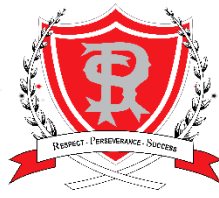

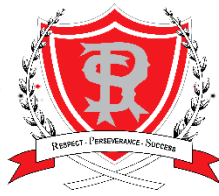
