SCHOOL UNIFORM TRANSITION PERIOD

As the weather begins to change, we will enter the transition period from summer uniform to winter uniform. From Wednesday, 8 April to Thursday, 30 April learners may wear either their full summer or winter uniform, depending on the days weather.

ALL learners are expected to be in full winter uniform from Monday, 4 May.

Please ensure that your child is dressed correctly in either their summer or winter uniform. Children are not allowed to mix and match their uniforms. The manner in which our learners present themselves in their school uniform reflects the image of our school. We have always had a high standard of dress code, please help us see to it that it remains the same.

A gentle reminder, please parents:

- Ties are a compulsory item for both boys and girls.
- Only grey beanies are permitted.
- Girls are allowed to wear tights during winter, but they must be grey and not black please.

GIRLS	BOYS
WINTER: Grey tunic with round neck or long grey pants, white long-sleeved shirt, school tie, grey knee-high socks with school colours or grey stockings, black shoes.	WINTER: Grey longs, white long-sleeved shirt, school tie, socks and shoes as for summer.
JERSEYS: Dark grey V-necked pullover, or a sleeveless pullover. Sleeveless pullover to be worn under jersey, not over.	
BLAZERS: <u>Compulsory</u> and must be worn on assembly days. Grey with school badge on pocket. Must be worn when entering and leaving school grounds.	
PHYS ED UNIFORM: Long red, tracksuit pants with matching red, tracksuit jacket. White, long-sleeved fleece-lined top with school badge. White takkies (no coloured takkies or white Tomy Takkies) and only white, ankle length socks are permitted. No secret socks to be worn. <i>NO black drimacs are allowed to be worn with any uniform at all.</i>
